**Timeline Calendar**

Friday, November 4th, 2022

- Notification to all Emergency Response Agencies and MTD

Friday, November 18, 2022

- Advance Notice of Special Event – 2 electronic message boards to be placed on Hollister Ave per the approved Traffic Control Plans

Saturday, November 19, 2022 from 0800 – 1200 Meet at Domingo's Café for Burritos

- Distribution of Parade Flyer and Street Closure to all merchants, business, and homeowners within the 500' area of North & South Hollister Ave between Fairview and Kellogg

Tuesday, November 29, 2022 from 1830 – 1930

- Information Meeting for Parade Participants held at Rusty's Pizza, Calle Real in Goleta

Wednesday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 0800 – finish

- Placement of all advance notice no-parking signs for Parade closure
- Placement of all driveways and parking lots on Hollister Ave and adjacent cross streets between Fairview Ave and Kellogg Ave will be closed from 1200 – 1900 on Saturday, December 3rd

Friday, December 2, 2022

- All barricades, cones, signs, and lights will be delivered to the storage lot on Hollister Ave
- Delivery of steel fences, dumpster, and restrooms
- Restrooms will be in place on private property, locations per final plan
- Dumpster will be placed in parking lot of GVCC, per final plan

Saturday, December 3, 2022 0800 to Noon??

- Set up signage in Parking areas
- Number locations on Orange Ave
- Entry area in GVCC
- Cardboard trash boxes will be assembled with liners, and placed on Hollister Ave and Orange Ave
- Pre-Stage all "Detour" and "Street Closure" signage on Hollister Ave and Orange Ave

- All cones and barricades will be placed in designated locations in preparation to be set out per final plan, at 1600
- All signage in parking lots will be set-up or hung
- Information Booth will be set-up on private property
- Pre-Stage participant parking lot, check in area, and participant staging area
- Radios will be distributed to parade coordinators
- Announcers Booths set up

#### Saturday, December 3rd, 4pm and 5pm

- Close down Orange Street, including placement of closure signs in driveways
- Cross walk monitors at Carson Ave will be in place
- Set up, Yardi parking lot traffic cones, participant check in area, participant staging area
- Arrival of volunteers, last minute instructions, final review of assignments and safety plan. Receive their reflective safety vests and move to their designated area, i.e. parking lots, parade route, or disembarking area. All volunteers will be in their designated spots 12 noon
- Upon approval from the Sheriff's Department, Hollister Ave will begin closing at 1700
- Message Boards are moved to new locations
- All parade monitors will close all driveways to ingress/egress
- Cones will be placed 10 feet from gutter on the Hollister Ave parade route
- All participants are checked-in and directed to their pre-parade spot

#### Parade begins 6:00pm

#### Saturday, December 3rd, End of Parade

- Street Sweeper cleans Hollister Ave
- Street signage removed after clean-up is finished
- Cones and barricades are stacked at various locations to be picked up on Hollister
- Pick up Trash Boxes along parade route
- Restrooms are picked up
- Dismantle Information Booth and Announcer Locations
- Tour of entire parade route, staging, disembarking, and any other areas used for the parade will take place to assure all items are completed prior to the opening of the streets
- All driveways and streets will re-open to traffic by 8:30 pm
- Members of the parade committee will take tour of the entire parade route, staging, disembarking, and any other areas used to assure all areas are returned to normal

#### Monday, December 5th, 2020

- All items located in the storage area will be picked up and stored
